Step 3: Include the AKC number of the dog being paid for so that we can match payment to the entry form.

Both payment and entry form must be received in order for your entry to be considered valid. Entries are processed only when both items are received. Entry forms must be emailed to clantyre.showsec@gmail.com to be considered valid.

Acknowledgement of entries will be made via email as soon as practicable.
Please include legible e-mail address on your entry form.
Do not send entries requiring a signature upon delivery.
Entries MUST include "A" or "B" and/or jump height (if applicable) in order to be processed.

Exhibitors providing email addresses will receive all communication, including confirmation and judging schedule through email.

Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules section of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Owners are responsible for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6.) No entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Returned checks, post-dated checks or declined credit cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made.

Effective January 1, 2024: An AKC Recording Fee of \$50 (first entry only), an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 for the first entry of a dog and \$3.50 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes will be required for each dog entered at all Licensed or Member Club events. An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 will be required for each entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. All Recording and Event Service Fees are collected by the event-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2 and AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 4)

If you use an entry service (superintendent, online entry or fax service) other than the Show Secretary listed in the premium, please be aware of their terms, additional charges and delivery policies.

**Entries are processed in the order that they are received
at the address of the Show Secretary.**

Notice to Exhibitors

- All judging will be indoors.
- Transfers will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16 and Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 15. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.
- The Rally rings are 40 x 50 feet. The two rally trials will run **concurrently**. Start times are likely to be offset to help avoid conflicts. Because the trials will run concurrently, transfers will not be accepted after the start time of the first trial.
- A wait-list will be established in order to fill openings created by entries that are withdrawn prior to the event closing day. Exhibitors who wish a UDX/RAE/RACH entry should check the box on the entry form. If all waitlisted classes do not become available by closing, the multiple-class entries will be returned and the next eligible waitlisted person will receive an available slot.
- Obedience and Rally classes will run in jump height order from "Tall-Small." Your jump height must be included on the entry form for all classes that require a jump.
- Food will **not** be available at the show site. Fast food is available within 2 miles.
- Free admission / Free parking. There is plenty of parking available.
- **REFUND POLICY:**
Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in obedience trials. The club will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee for bitches in season that are unable to compete for that reason. Refund requests must be accompanied by a dated, signed letter on official business letterhead from your veterinarian stating the reason that your dog cannot compete. The Trial Secretary must be notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial. E-mails, phone calls and non-letterhead notes will not be considered.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Show Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. No dogs under 4 months of age on show grounds. There will be no smoking in the building. Please dispose of all trash in the proper manner.
- The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called. All dogs present must be held on a leash, or confined to a crate except when being judged.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The host club, Clantyre Show Secretary Services and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, illness or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. Anyone in violation of a restriction pursuant to AKC rules or policies, or the law can be asked to leave the grounds. If the person fails to leave, the local authorities will be contacted. In addition, if the club believes laws, restrictions, or conditions of release are being violated by an individual's attendance or participation in AKC events, the local authorities will be contacted immediately as they have the authority of enforcement.

From the North, East, or South:

Follow I-695 (Baltimore Beltway) to Exit 19 (I-795) towards Owings Mills/Reisterstown continuing until the expressway ends. Bear right onto Route 140 West (towards Westminster) continuing for 10.9 miles to the light at Center Street. Turn left at the light onto Center Street. Proceed 1.6 miles through a four-way stop sign and two traffic lights. Go past the Farm Museum on the right and Carroll Hospital on the left and you will be at the stop sign at Gist Road. Turn right onto Gist Road. Drive 0.1 miles and turn right onto Ag Center drive.

From the East or South - Alternate route (more back road driving):

Take Route 32 West (to Sykesville/Westminster). Turn left on Kate Wagner Road. Turn right onto Gist Road. After you pass Smith Ave turn left onto Ag Center drive.

From the West:

From I-70 Exit 68 – Route 27 North to right onto Kate Wagner Rd. Turn left onto Gist Road and follow alternate route directions above.

From I-70 Exit 76 – Route 97 North to left on Hook Road. Turn right onto Gist Road and follow alternate route directions above.



- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time the entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of the acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
